Minutes of the General Meeting
January 24, 2022
Virtual Meeting via Zoom

Welcome: After conversation rooms, President Callista Bevans opened the meeting at 9:37 AM.

Announcements: Callista announced the next boutique would be held Saturday, March 19 from 10 to 1 PM at the home of member Gloria Kahn. Callista will hold a mini meeting between 11 and 12.

Block Party: the winner for January was Diane Tippet.

Programs: Sue Bianchi announced the speaker in February will be David Owens Hastings and that there is still space in the workshop.
